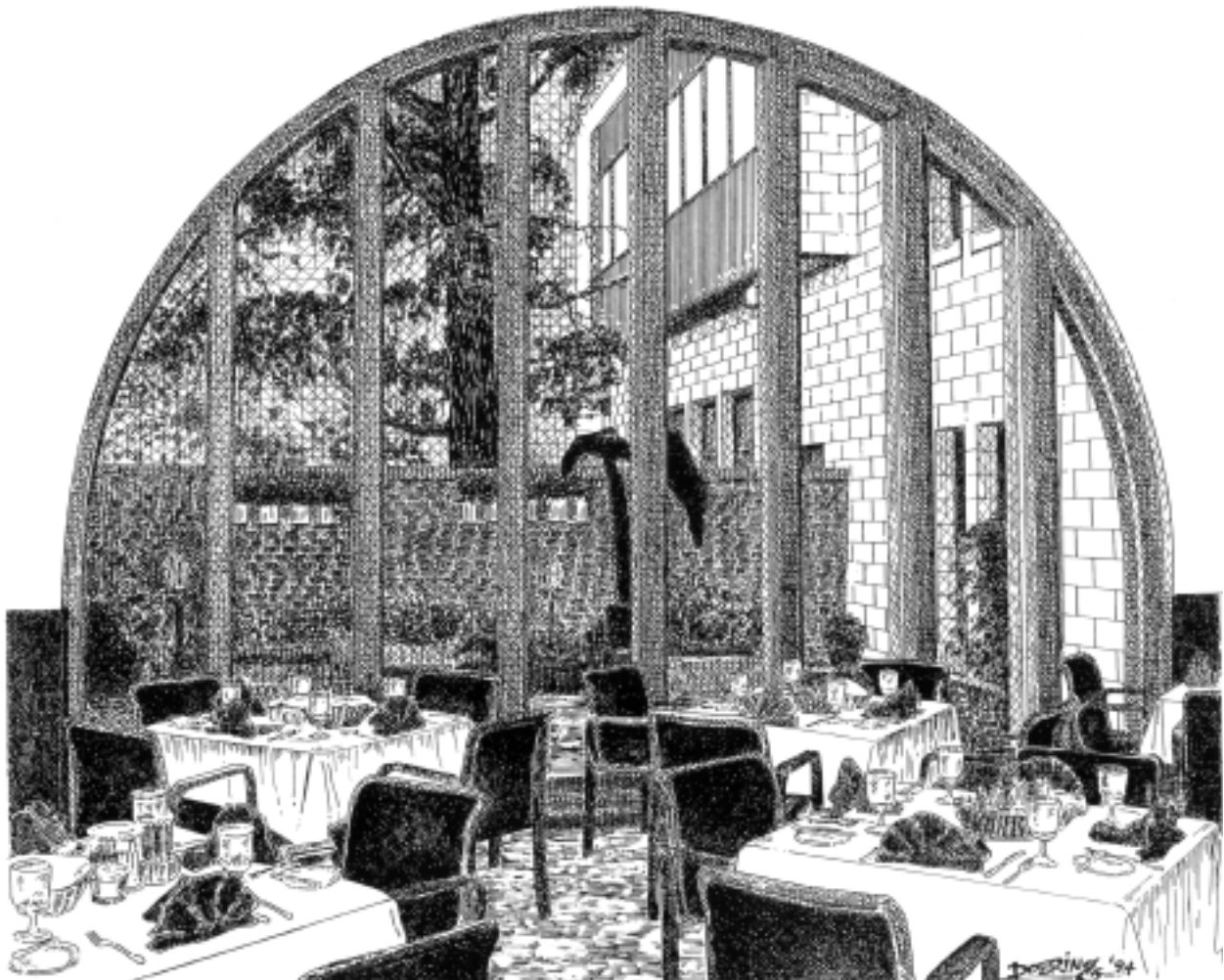

PROCEDURES FOR ELECTION TO MEMBERSHIP

1. Completed Proposal for Membership application form, signed by the candidate and proposing member, should be mailed or delivered to the Sangamo Club.
2. The candidate's proposal is presented to the Board of Directors by the Membership Committee Chair. The Board generally meets on the third Wednesday of each month, reviews the recommendations and takes final action.
3. The candidate's name, business affiliation and the name of the candidate's sponsor are entered on the 'Proposed Members' list to be posted in the lobby of the Club. If no member objects within five working days, the proposed member is accepted as a member of the Sangamo Club.
4. Candidates are advised of the Board's action by the Secretary within a few days after the end of the five working days have elapsed. Payment of the initiation fee and first month's dues and improvement fund assessment are billed at the first of the next month.

MEMBERSHIP IN THE SANGAMO CLUB

Membership in the Sangamo Club can be in one of several categories. The following initiation fee and dues policies apply.

RESIDENT

An applicant age 35 or above of good moral character whose permanent residence, except for temporary absences, is within 50 miles of Springfield.

Initiation Fee	\$1,250.00
Dues	85.00 per month
Club Improvement Fund.	12.00 per month

Qualified Business Privileges

Candidates who work full-time for a Qualified Business receive a 50% discount off the initiation fee. A Qualified Business is a non-governmental business or not-for-profit agency employing three or more Resident members on a full-time basis.

Qualified Businesses Employee Waivers

When a member ceases to remain a full-time employee of a Qualified Business, the Club will establish one initiation fee waiver in the name of the Qualified Business. The Qualified Business may then designate another of its full-time employees to receive a waiver of an initiation fee. The waiver must be used within three months.

SENIOR RESIDENT

Any resident Member whose combined age and number of years as a Club member totals 100 shall qualify for Senior Resident Membership. To become a Senior Resident Member, the qualifying Member must notify the Club in writing of their intention to transfer to Senior status.

Dues	\$127.50 per quarter
Club Improvement Fund.	36.00 per quarter

YOUNG PROFESSIONAL

An applicant, age 21 through 34 who, except for temporary absences, is within 50 miles of Springfield, may apply for Young Professional membership. When a Young Professional member becomes 35, he/she shall be a Resident Member.

Initiation Fee.	\$650.00
Dues (Age 21-34)	47.00 per month
Club Improvement Fund.	10.00 per month

Half of the initiation fee is payable within 30 days after application approval. The balance is to be paid in equal yearly installments each January prior to applicant's 35th birth date.

NON-RESIDENT

A person of good character whose permanent home is more than 50 miles from Springfield, and whose residence within 50 mile limit is only temporary or occasional.

Initiation Fee.	\$400.00
Dues	145.50 per quarter

Non-Resident Lobbyist Transfers

A Non-Resident Member registered as a lobbyist may transfer credit for the initiation fee to a new Non-Resident applicant. The applicant must be replacing the Member as the new registered lobbyist for the same entity. The existing member must identify the name of the new lobbyist and must tender a resignation to the Club.

SENIOR NON-RESIDENT

Any Non-Resident Member whose combined age and number of years as a Club Member totals 100 shall qualify for Senior Non-Resident Membership. To become a Senior Non-Resident Member, the qualifying Member must notify the Club in writing of their intention to transfer to Senior status.

Dues	\$72.25 per quarter
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HONORARY

Honorary memberships are offered to the following State of Illinois elected officials: Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Comptroller, Treasurer and Attorney General. Honorary membership shall be offered to the elected Mayor of the City of Springfield, Illinois. Honorary membership for elected officials shall terminate at the expiration of their tenure in the office. Honorary membership may be offered to such other persons as the Board determines and may be granted to a Resident Member in recognition of long and faithful service to the Club.

MISCELLANEOUS

Surviving Spouse

The surviving spouse of a deceased Member will be invited to assume the Club membership. Member classification will be based on the surviving spouse's age. Senior status will be based on the surviving spouse's age plus the number of years of membership based on the original initiation date.

Family Member Waivers

The initiation fee of any candidate who is at least 21 years old will be waived if proposed by a parent, grandparent, step parent, child or spouse who is a member.

Membership Category Transfers

When a Non-Resident Member transfers to Resident or Young Professional, and the applicant has not previously been a Resident or Young Professional Member, the transfer fee will be the difference paid for Non-Resident membership and the current Resident or Young Professional membership fee. There is no fee for Resident or Young Professional Members who transfer to Non-Resident membership.

Reinstatement

A former Member of the Club who was in good standing upon termination may, upon application, be reinstated as a Member. A reinstatement payment is required to the Club equal to the amount the former Member would have paid as a building assessment had he/she not terminated membership, plus \$50.00. In no event will the fee exceed the amount of the current initiation fee.

Holiday Bonus

Each year in October, all members shall be assessed a fee, to be determined by the Board of Directors to create a holiday fund to be paid to the Club employees in December.
